Sample SETI Oral Tasks

Task description

You will have to do three tasks after maximum five minutes of preparation time, but you may start earlier if you wish. During preparation, you may have a look at the pictures, read the statement and take notes.

During the interview, you may be asked questions by one of the examiners. Each part may last up to 5 minutes.

Part 1

In this part of the interview you are expected to talk about yourself without too much help. Topics you could include or the examiners may ask you about are, for example:

Facts, personality, home and family, habits, hobbies, attitudes, skills and knowledge, experience, education, etc.

Part 2

In this part of the interview you will receive two pictures. You are expected to compare and/or link the two pictures. For example:





You may add your thoughts, associations, opinion and experience freely. You may have to answer the examiner's questions.

Part 3

In this part of the oral interview, you will receive a statement. You will need to give your opinion on the statement or related issues. For example:

Chemistry is a useless subject.

OR

There is too much emphasis put on beauty these days.

Assessment

Your orals skills will be evaluated on the basis of the SETI Oral Interview Criteria by both examiners independently (see separate document). The maximum score is 50.
